

## **How to Document Your Tour Stops**

### 2020 Tour of the Motorcycle Grand Tour of Texas


Registered participants will receive a rally flag with their individual participant number. The tour will start on March 1, 2020 and end on November 15, 2020. Do not submit tour stop photos prior to March 1, 2020.

The tour stop locations will be posted on the tour web site. The number of points each stop is worth is posted on the tour stops page. To be considered a Tour Finisher, registered participants must ride to at least half of the tour stops and properly document the stops.

The participants are to take a picture of their motorcycle and their rally flag at the tour stops. Ensure that the picture shows the tour stop in the background (i.e. signage, statue, monument, etc.). If it is unsafe to take the picture, do not take it. If conditions make it impossible and/or unsafe to get your motorcycle in the picture, but you can get a picture of your rally flag and yourself in the picture safely, do so. Up to 10% of your pictures may be without your motorcycle in the picture. If you submit a picture without your motorcycle, you and your rally flag must be in the picture.

Participants shall upload the picture to the Picture Submission Portal (PSP) on the website in order to receive credit for the stop. The first picture to submit needs to be a close-up of your tour flag. After you submit that picture, you can start submitting pictures of the individual tour stops and of receipts from sponsors/non-profits. Do not submit all of your pictures at one time. Send them as you go. It is important that the rally flag number be clearly visible and that the tour stop be clearly identifiable in the photo. The Tour Coordinator will have the final say on all submissions.

Participants can receive additional points for purchases that they make with the sponsors. To do so, they must email a picture of a receipt from the sponsor's business.

A maximum of three receipts per business may be submitted. For purchases of \$1.00 to \$50.00, participants will receive five points. For purchases of \$50.01 or more, participants will receive 10 points. With the exception of lodging businesses, the total of the individual receipts (not the individual items purchased) is what counts for the receipt points. For receipts from sponsors in the lodging business, each separate day spent with the lodging sponsor will be counted separately for purposes of calculating points earned. For example, if you stay two consecutive nights at \$100 per night, your receipt totaling \$200 would count as two receipts and earn 20 points instead of 10 points. If you stay four consecutive nights, the receipt would count as three (the maximum) receipts and you would earn 30 points.

The pictures of receipts submitted shall be named in the same format as for pictures of tour stops. Make sure the photo of the sponsor's receipt clearly shows the sponsor's name, date of purchase, and amount of purchase. The tour coordinator shall have final say on all submissions.

This document is meant to be a quick reference that you can printout. The Rules for Participation web page, which must be read as part of the registration process, has more details regarding the tour requirements.
